In the discipline Chamber Ensembles with accordion or Diatonic accordion the use of music is allowed. The organizer has to provide music stands. For the other instruments on stage (e.g. percussion, piano...) competitor should ask organizer for details.

A special prize can be awarded in category F (classical music soloists) if the competitor reaches 95 points or more. In this case, the organizer provides the winner concert at the next competition. A competitor or a group can not win two cash prizes. For the 1st place prize money, the competitor or group must reach at least 95 points and at least 90 points for the 2nd and 3rd place. All cash award are paid in NET amounts.

The results will be published until 21:00 on the day of the competition in each category.

The granting of the awards will be part of all the events of the 19. International Accordion Competition »PannoniAccordion«. At the final concert each prizewinner has to perform a part of the programme, defined by the jury. If the recipient of the financial award does not perform a specific programme at the final concert, the award will not be paid to him. The members of the jury will be acknowledged European musicians and successful professors. The evaluation by the jury is ultimate.

The participants of competition undertake to waive the fee in case of public broadcasting of recordings from the competition on radio or television. The amount of the registration fee is not refunded to the participant who does not participate in the competition.

The organizer of the competition is not responsible for possible injuries or other accidents of the participants (competitors, mentors, jury, organizers, exhibitors and listeners) occurring in the premises or outside venues of the competition. Also, the organizer is not responsible for damage or alienation of their property.

The competition will be public and takes place in Murska Sobota Castle (Baroque Salon, MIKK Hall, Castle Hall), Trubarjev drevored 4, 9000 Murska Sobota, Slovenia and The Park Theater Murska Sobota. The exact schedule of the appearances will be published 14 days before the start of the competition on the website. Each registered candidate must report at the information office at least 1 hour before the competition starts in the category that he is registered for. Each soloist must prepare 3 copies of music (not necessary for the competitors in categories »Folk music«), and the chamber group and orchestra 5 copies of the competition program.

If the competitor does not submit all the required copies of music on time, he will be excluded from the competition.

Besides the competition, interesting concerts, the presentation of music material and instruments, there will also be a professional meeting of teachers, professors and concert performers.
